



Safety First for Our Patients and Staff

We are following the procedures set forth by the Center for Disease Control & Prevention, American Academy of Ophthalmology, as well as state health departments.

- **Patients will remain in vehicle and “check-in” for appointment by phone.**
- **Patients must wear a mask in order to enter the building.**
- **Patients will be screened prior to entering the testing and exam rooms. Non-contact temperatures will be taken.**
- **Person accompanying patient will remain in vehicle unless patient requires assistance or is a minor.**
- **Patients will follow social distancing rules and observe “floor taping” which identifies safe spacing and patient directional guidance.**
- **Our staff will use Personal Protective Equipment including masks, sanitizer, cough shields, and gloves if needed.**
- **Frequent antiseptic wipe downs in the office, and in exam rooms between patients.**
